RCAC Guidelines for Officers and Eligibility:

Section 1: Officers. There shall be a chairperson and a 1st vice chairperson and

2nd vice chairperson of the RCAC elected for two-year terms.

Section 2: Eligibility for Office. Eligibility for election as chairperson or vice chairpersons of the RCAC is restricted to a person who is either serving as an officer of a CCAC or has completed a term as such, or a person designed as the RCAC representative from their respective CCAC, or a person who is serving or has served a complete term as the RCAC chairperson, vice chairperson, or standing committee chairperson.
